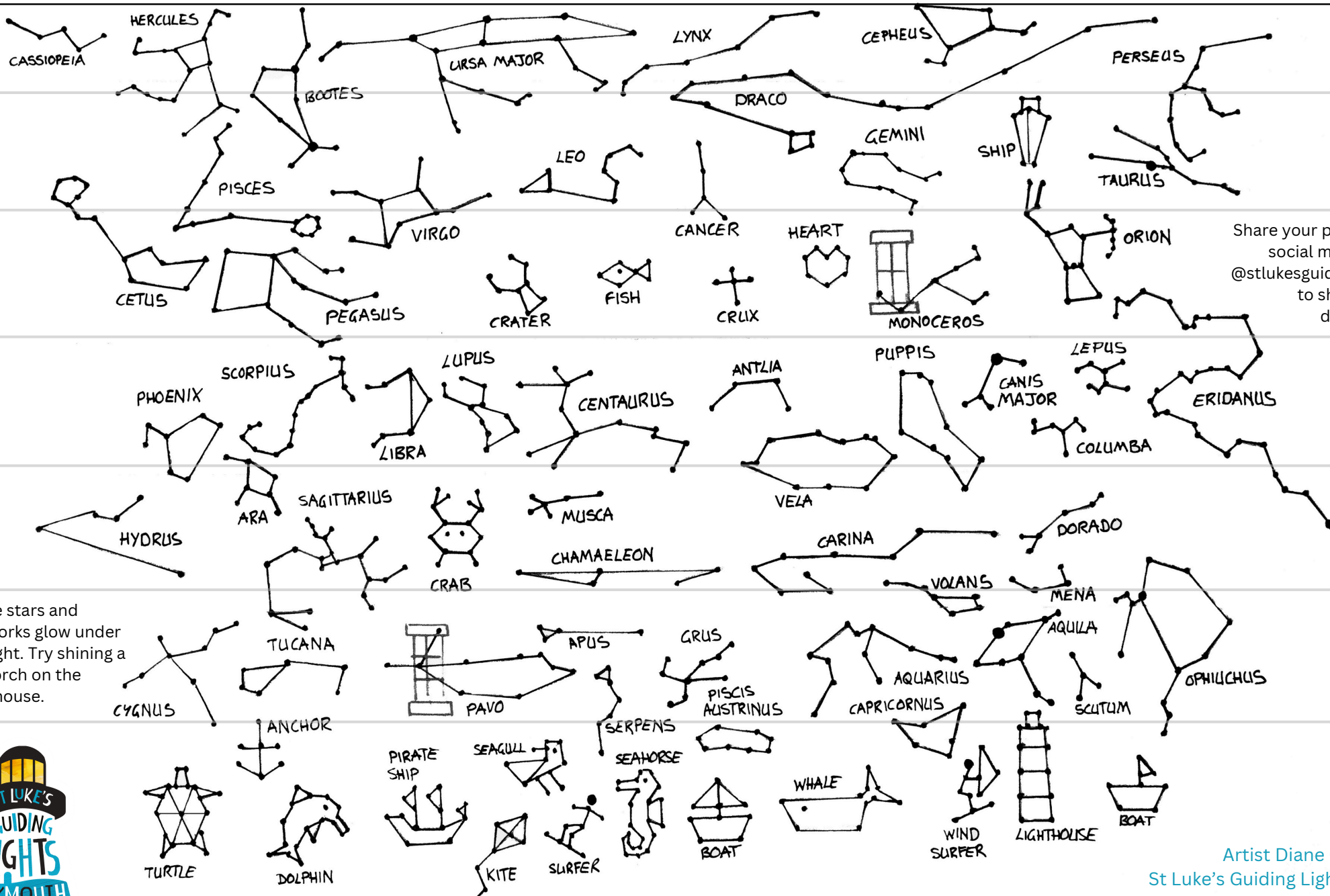


# Celestial Beacon Guide Map

# Constellations

## Did you know?

Several constellations appear in the sky of Celestial Beacon. Here are a few you might recognise when looking up at the sculpture.

|                            |   |
|----------------------------|---|
| Orion                      | One of the easiest constellations to spot in the UK winter sky.<br>The three bright stars in a straight line form Orion's Belt. |
| The Plough<br>(Ursa Major) | Not actually a constellation! but an "asterism" = a recognisable star pattern which makes up part of Ursa Major.                |
| Cassiopeia                 | Forms a distinctive "W" shape in the sky.<br>Visible all year round in the UK.  |
| Taurus                     | Contains the Pleiades star cluster, often called the Seven Sisters.   |
| Canis Major                | Home to Sirius, the brightest star in the night sky.<br>Sirius is nearly twice the size as our Sun and about 25 times brighter! |
